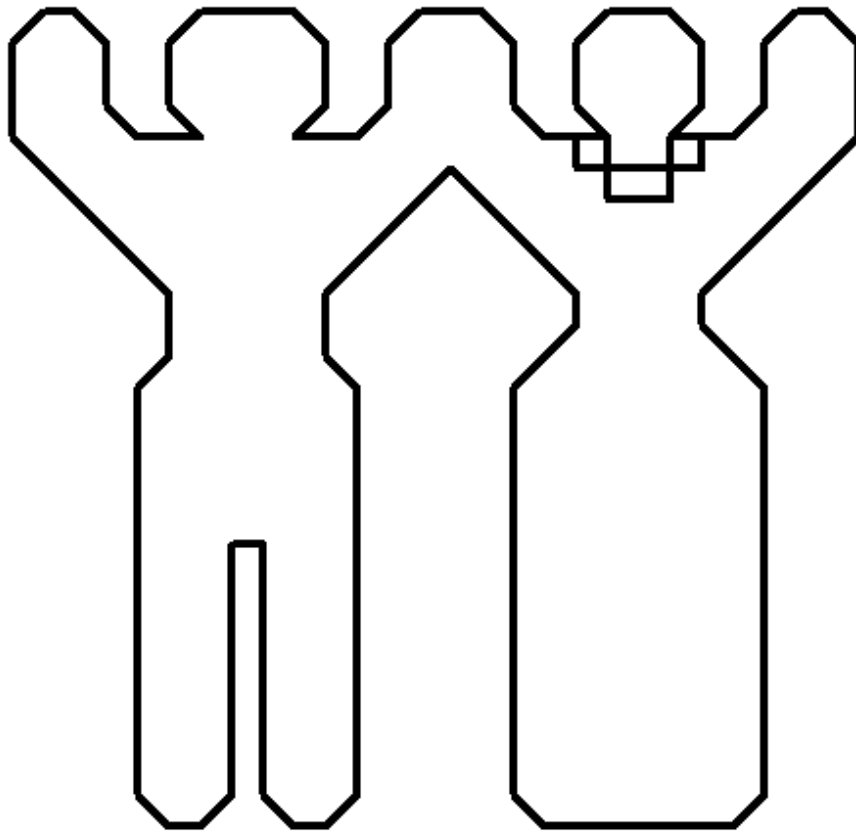


Creation

God created all people to be like him and to serve him.

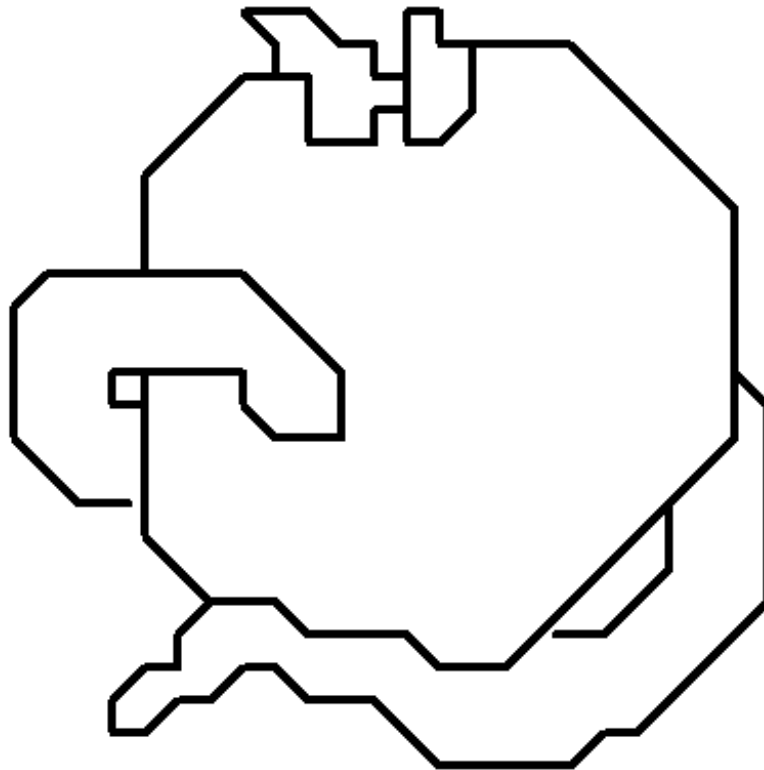


So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them. Genesis 1:27

the fruit God had told her not to eat.*

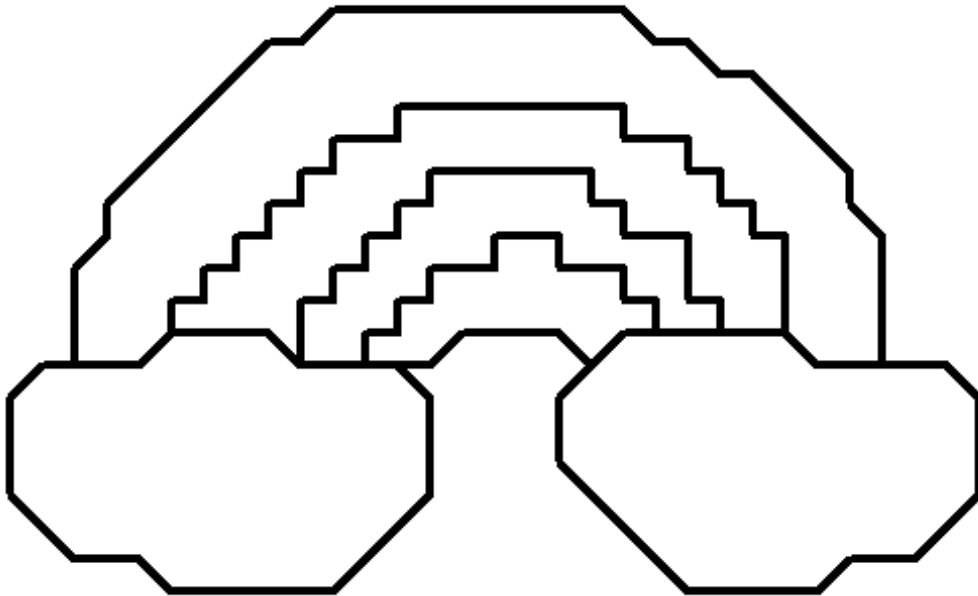

God said that whenever a rainbow appears, it is to remind us of his promise to never again send a flood to destroy the earth.

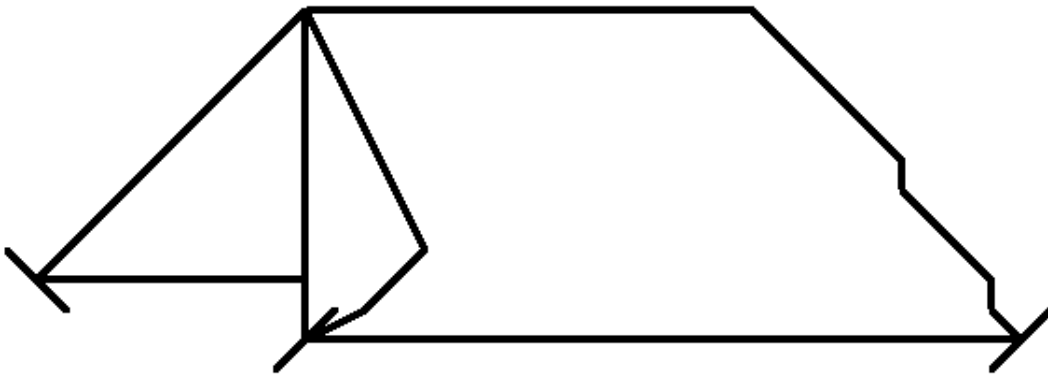


I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. Genesis 9:13

God asked Abraham to leave his country and travel to a strange land. He lived in tents in the desert.

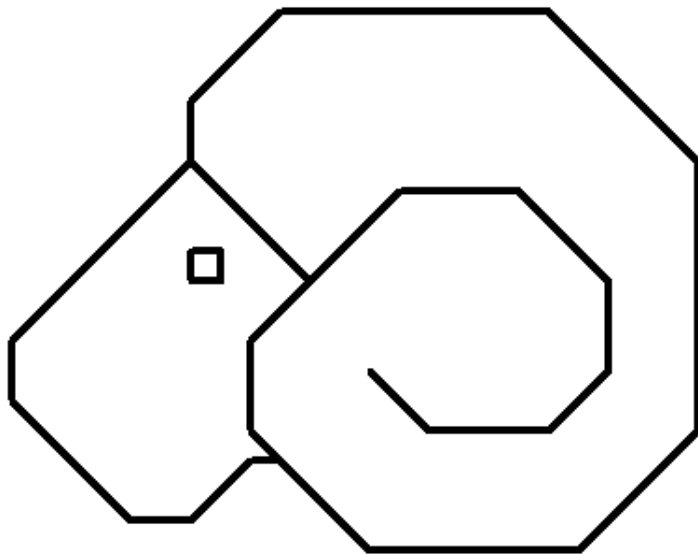


*The Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land."

he learned that God would provide for his needs.*

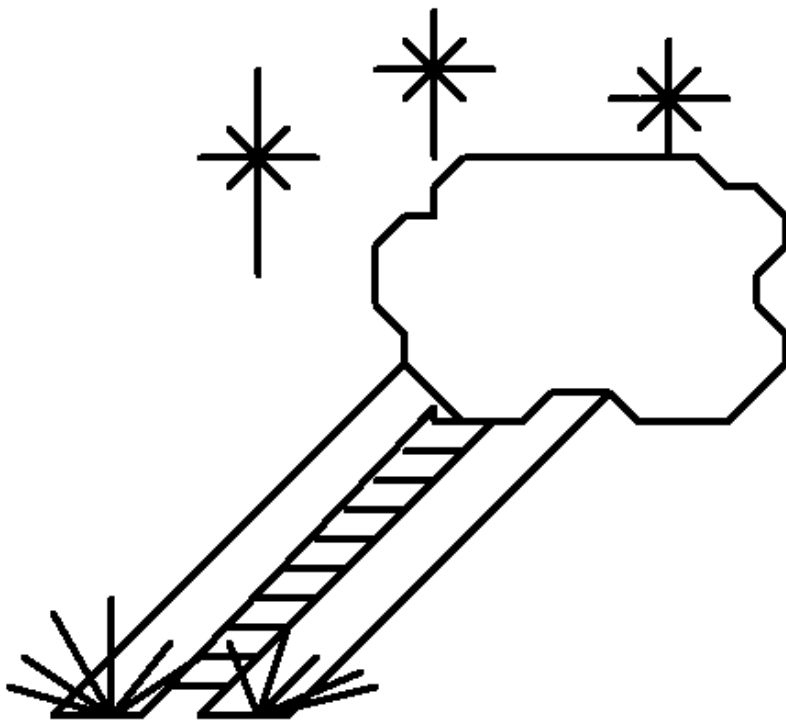


*Abraham looked up and there in a thicket he saw a ram caught by its horns. He went over and took the ram and sacrificed it as a burnt offering instead of his son.

Jacob had a dream about a ladder to heaven. God reminded him that he would keep all the promises he had made to Abraham.

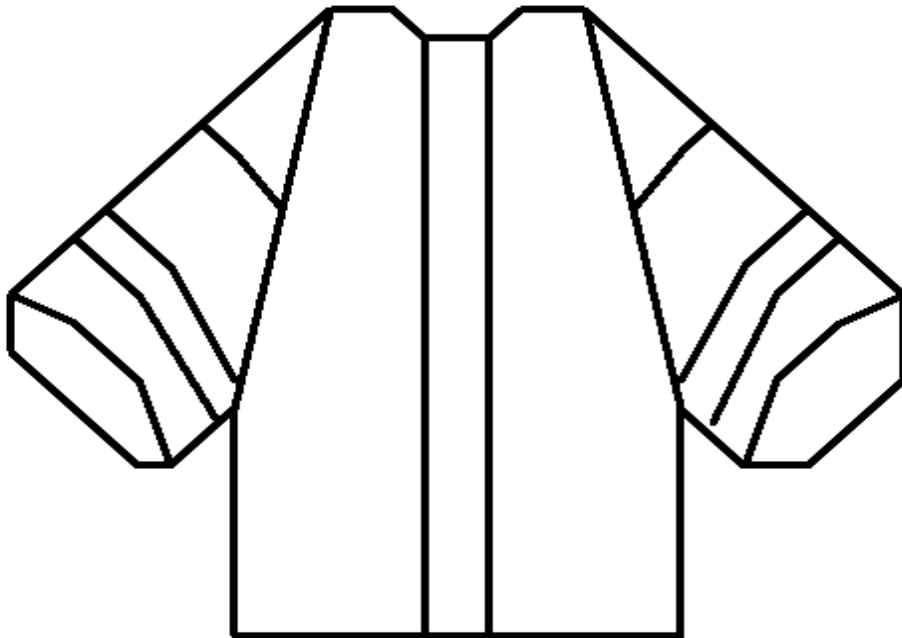


*He had a dream in which he saw a stairway resting on the earth, with its top reaching to heaven, and the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

Joseph's father gave him a beautiful coat. His brothers were jealous and they sold him to slave traders. God made all things work out so his promises would come true.

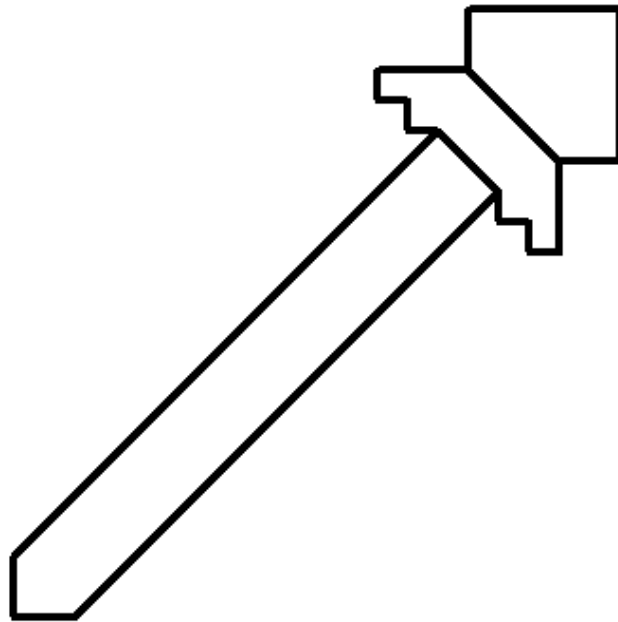


Now Israel loved Joseph more than any of his other sons, because he had been born to him in his old age; and he made a richly ornamented robe for him. Genesis 37:3

A scepter is a sign of royal authority. God promised that his Son would come from Judah's tribe and that he would reign over all the nations of the earth.

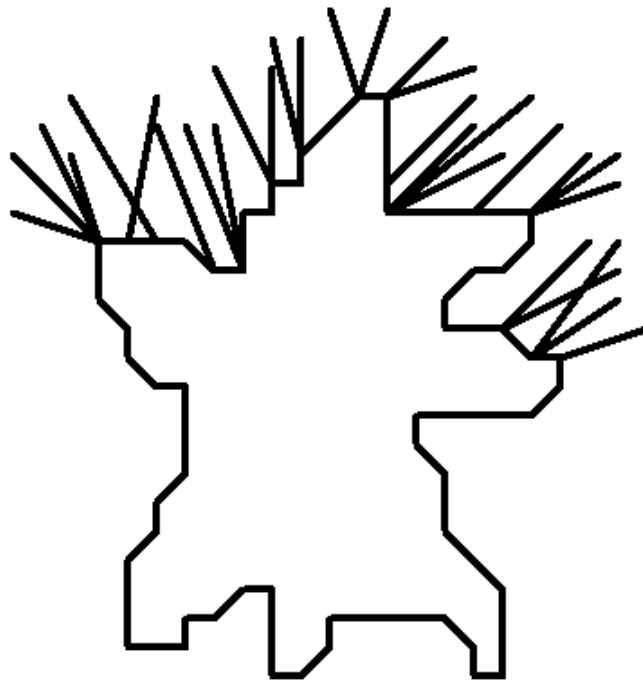


The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his. Genesis 49:10

Moses saw a burning bush. God reminded Moses that he would keep the promises he had made to Abraham.

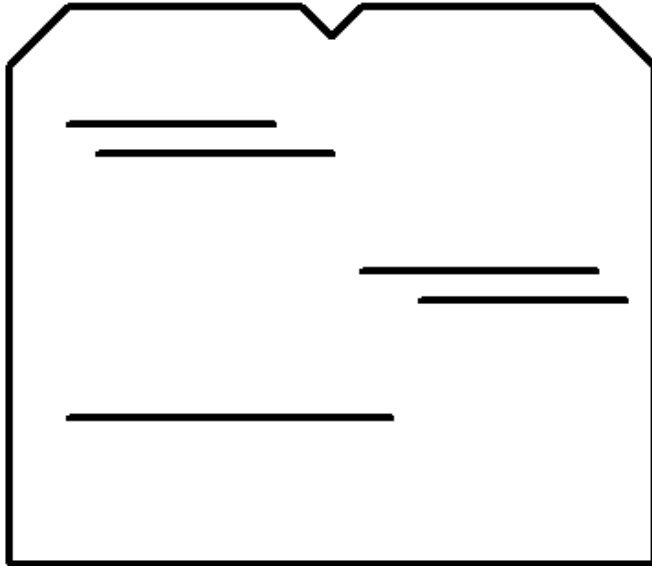


There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up. Exodus 3:2

God told his people what his laws were. He wanted his people to do the right things so they would please him.

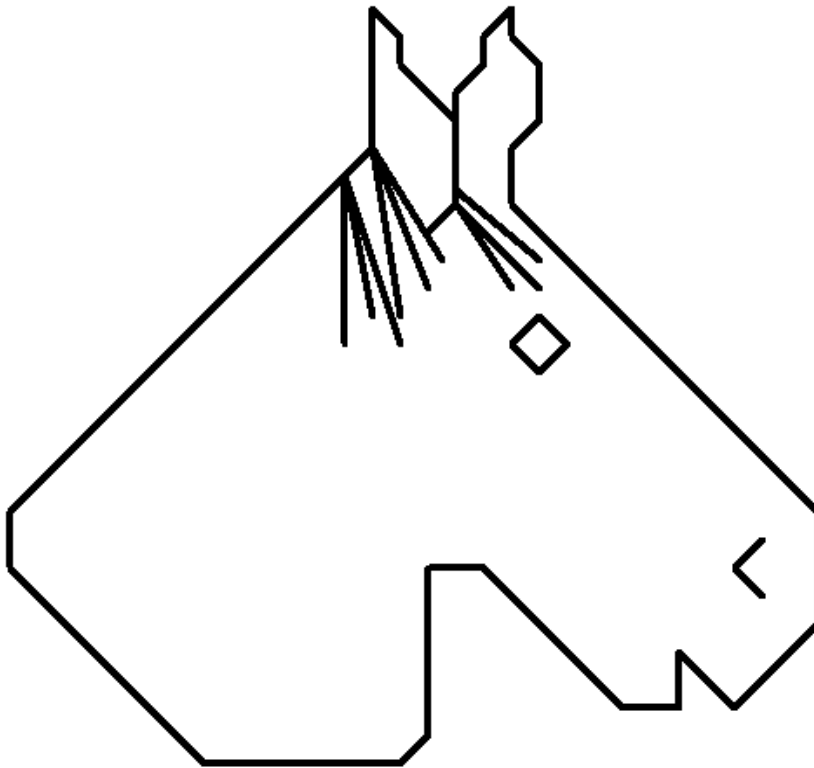


*Moses summoned all of Israel and said: "Hear, O Israel, the decrees and laws I declare in your hearing today. Learn them and be sure to follow them."

Balaam's donkey could see God's angel, even when Balaam couldn't. She saved Balaam's life three times.

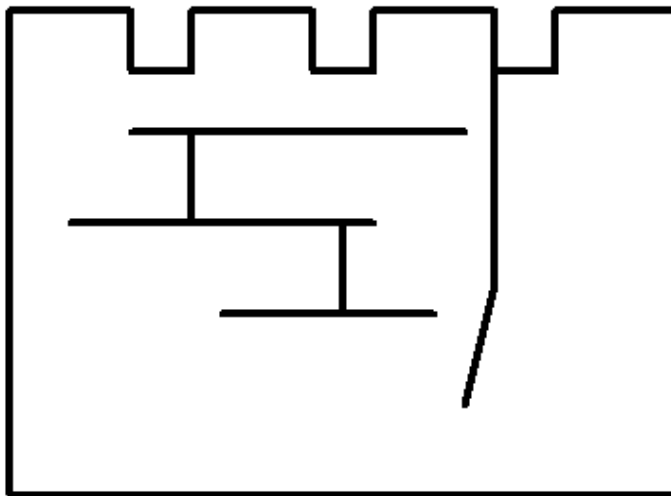


Balaam got up in the morning, saddled his donkey and went with the princes of Moab. Numbers 22:21

Rahab wanted God to protect her and her family, even though she was not part of God's people. She put a red cord out the window to remind the Israelites where her house was.

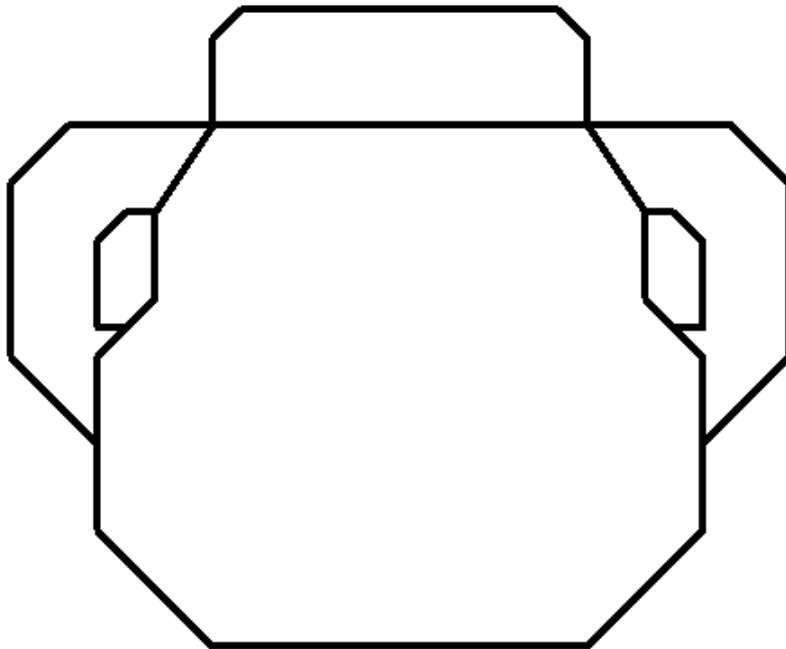


“Agreed,” she replied. “Let it be as you say.” So she sent them away and they departed. And she tied the scarlet cord in the window.” Joshua 2:21

Gideon's soldiers surrounded the enemy and broke the jars they were carrying. God fought the battle for Israel and helped them win.

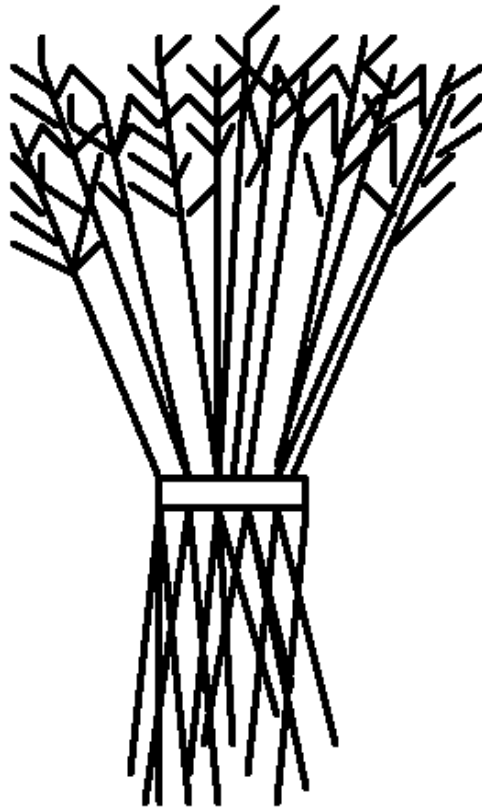

Ruth gathered grain in the fields. She wanted God to protect her, so God blessed her and she became part of the Jesse tree.

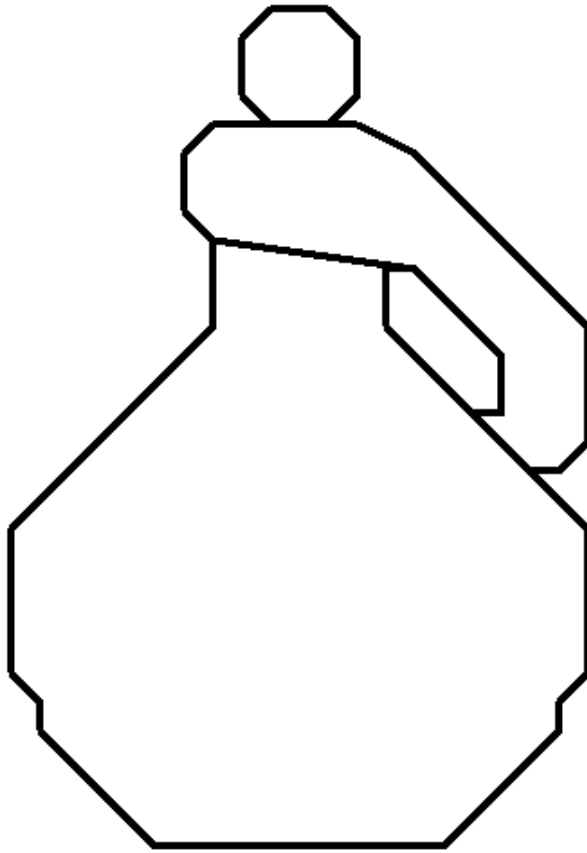

Samuel anointed David with oil to show that God had chosen David to be King and rule over his people Israel.

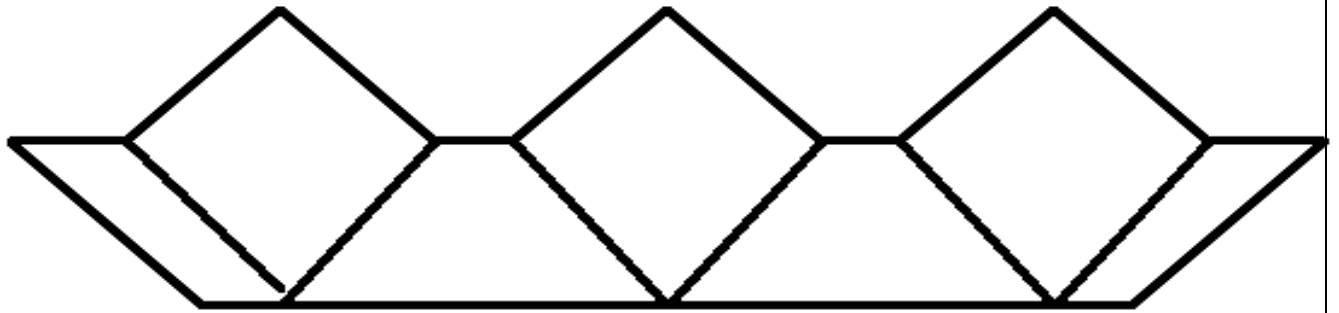

He wore a King's crown.*

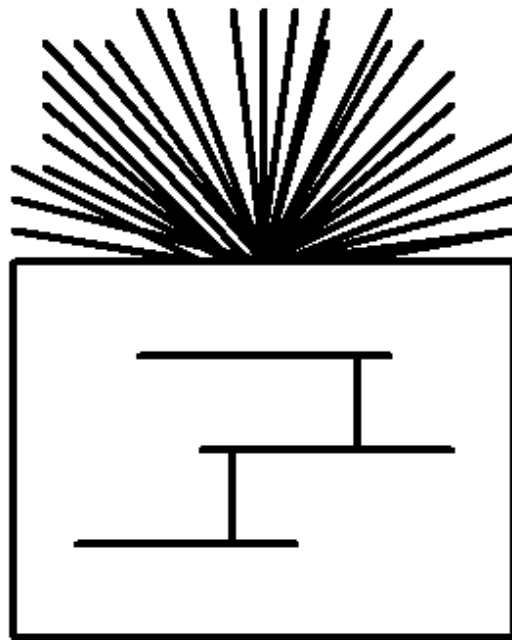

The true God answered Elijah's prayer and sent fire to burn up the altar.

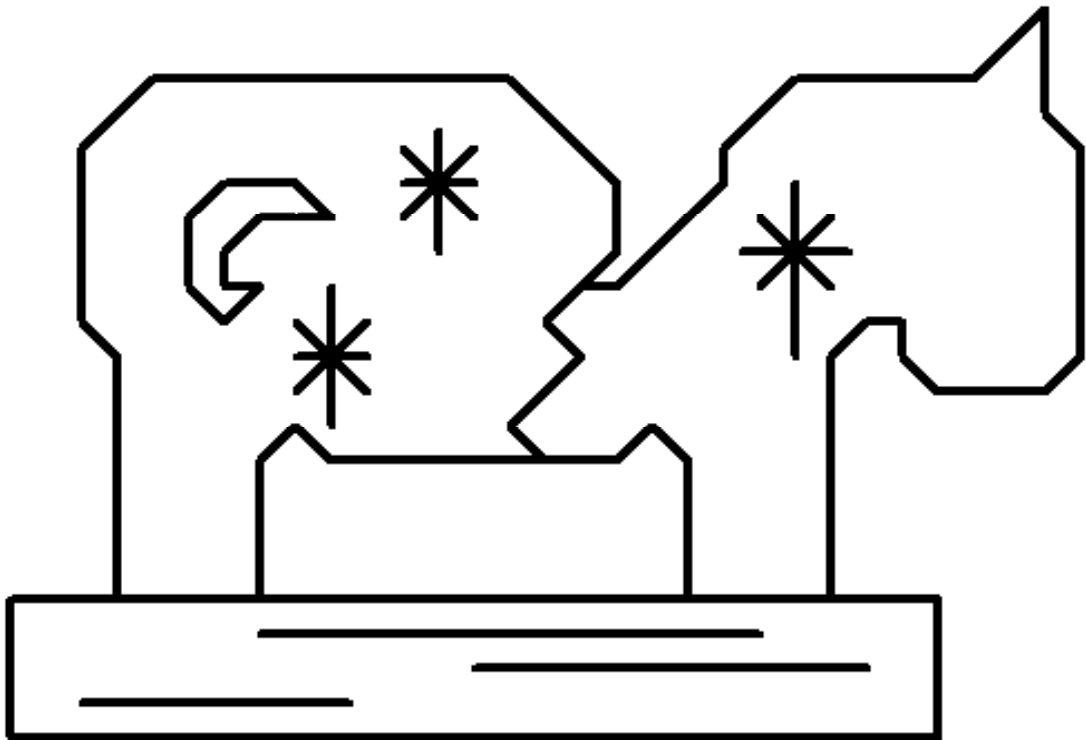


Then the fire of the Lord fell and burned up the sacrifice, the wood, the stones and the soil, and also licked up the water in the trench. 1 Kings 18:38

King Hezekiah wanted the people to worship only God and not their idols. He broke all the idols the people had.

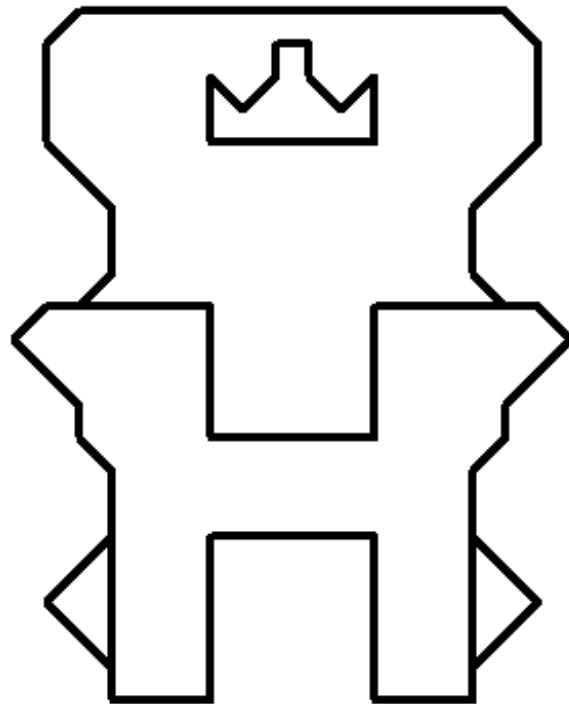


He removed the high places, smashed the sacred stones, and cut down the Asherah poles. II Kings 18:4

God's Son will rule on God's throne.

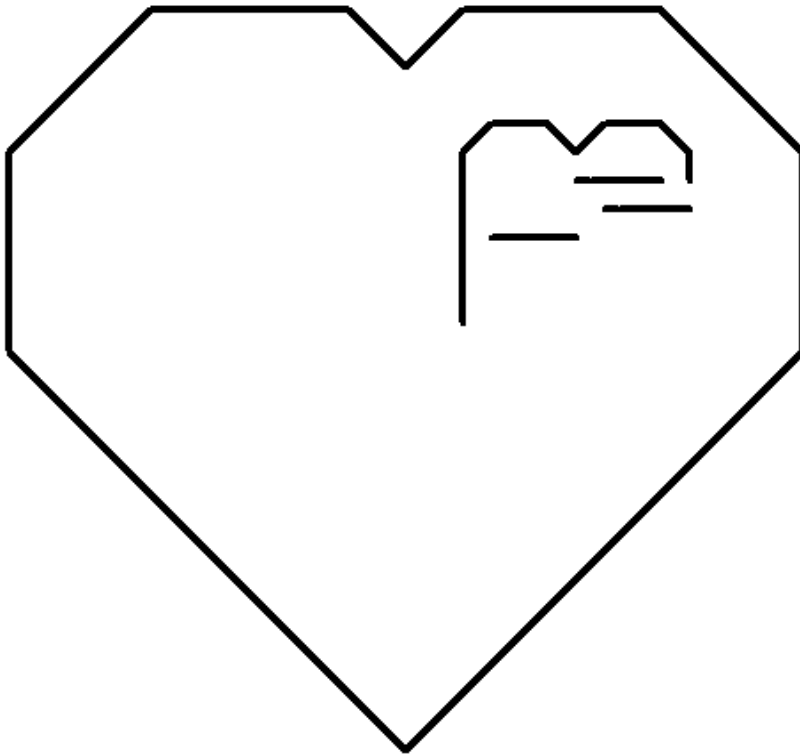

God promised to give his people a new heart so they would love him and serve him.

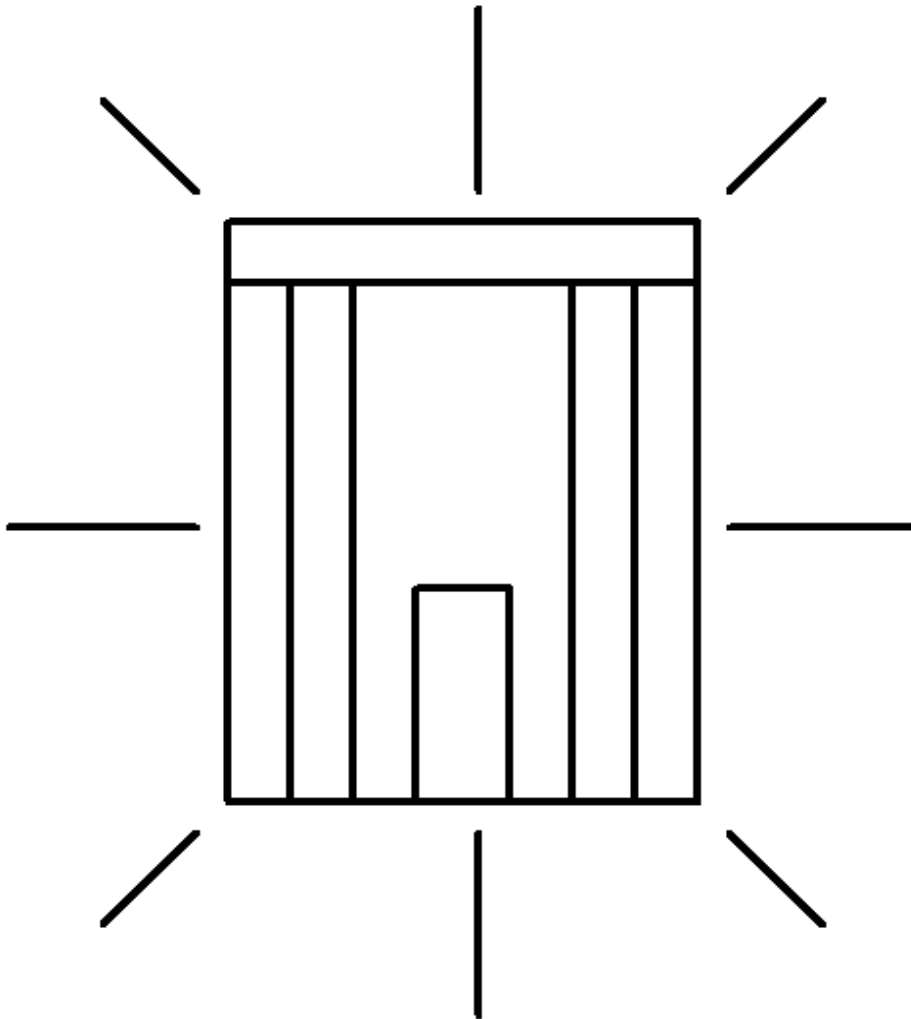


I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God and they will be my people. Jeremiah 31:33

God came into the temple Haggai built, and he promised to come into a future temple. One day Jesus entered that temple, just as God promised.

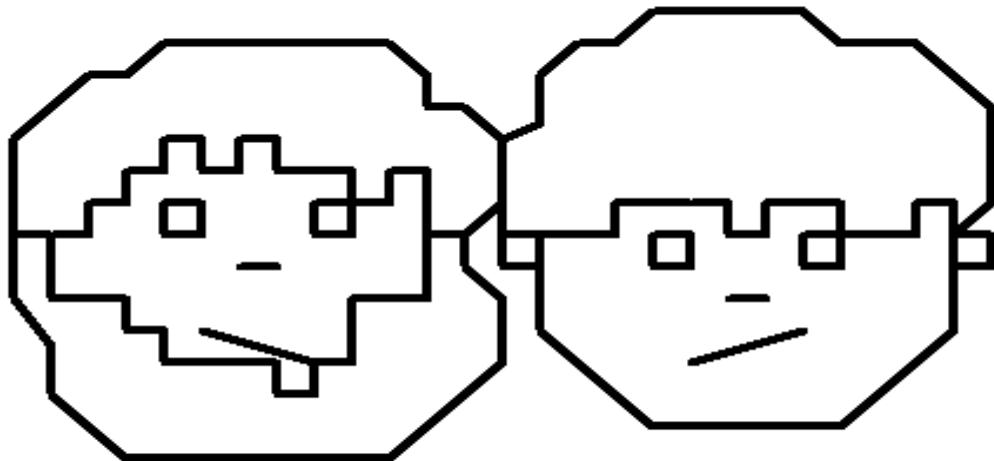

Elizabeth and Zechariah were old and had never been able to have children. But God gave them a son named John. He was the one who prepared the way for Jesus.

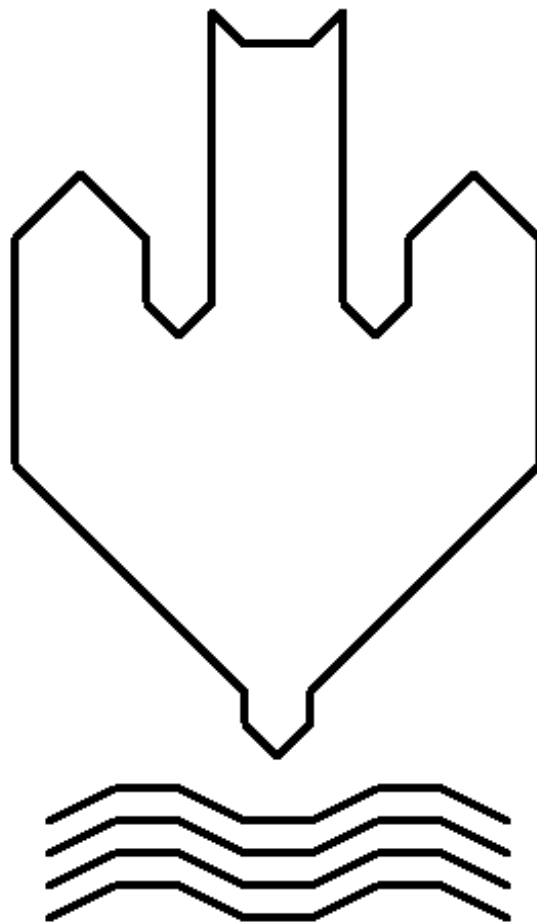


Blessed is she who has believed that what the Lord has said to her will be accomplished! Luke 1:45

John the Baptist preached in the wilderness and many of God's people repented. John baptized them in the water. He also baptized Jesus, and the Holy Spirit appeared as a dove.

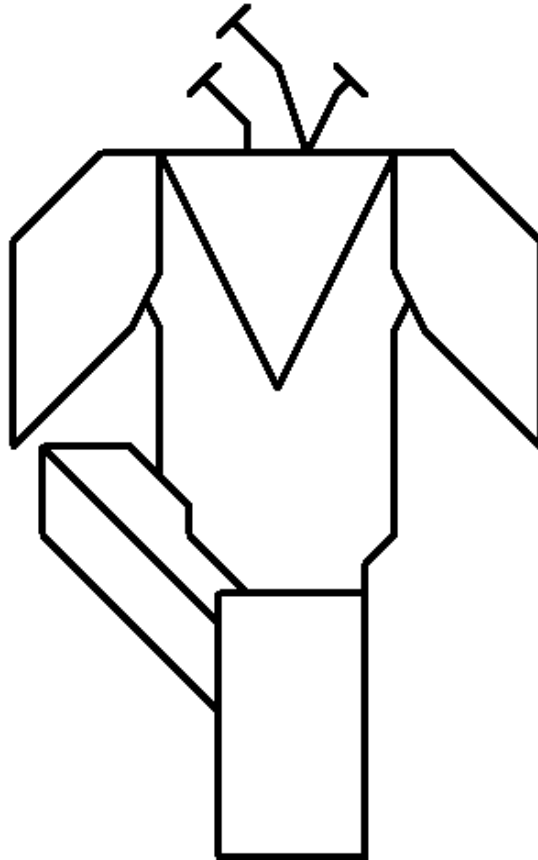

A white lily represents Mary's purity.

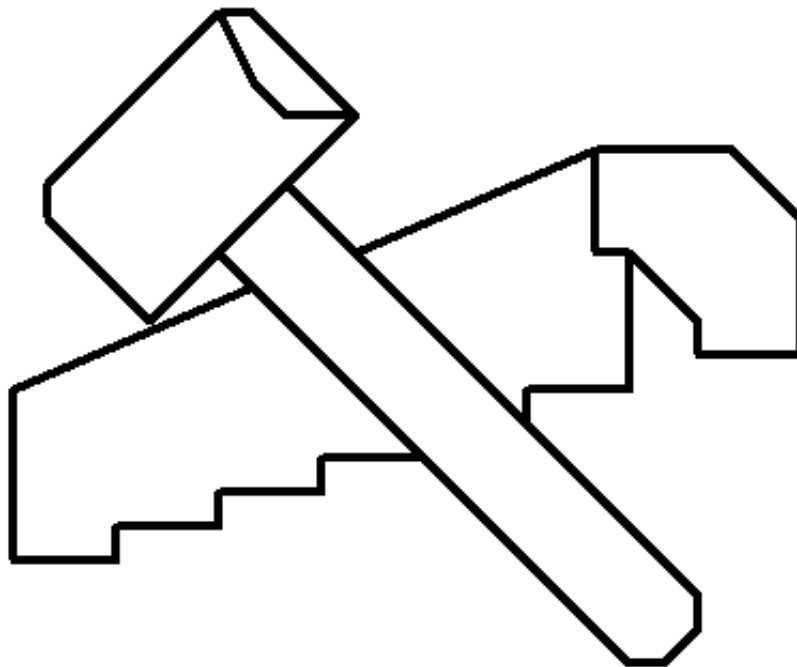

Joseph was a humble carpenter, and God used him to raise Jesus and take care of him while he was a child.

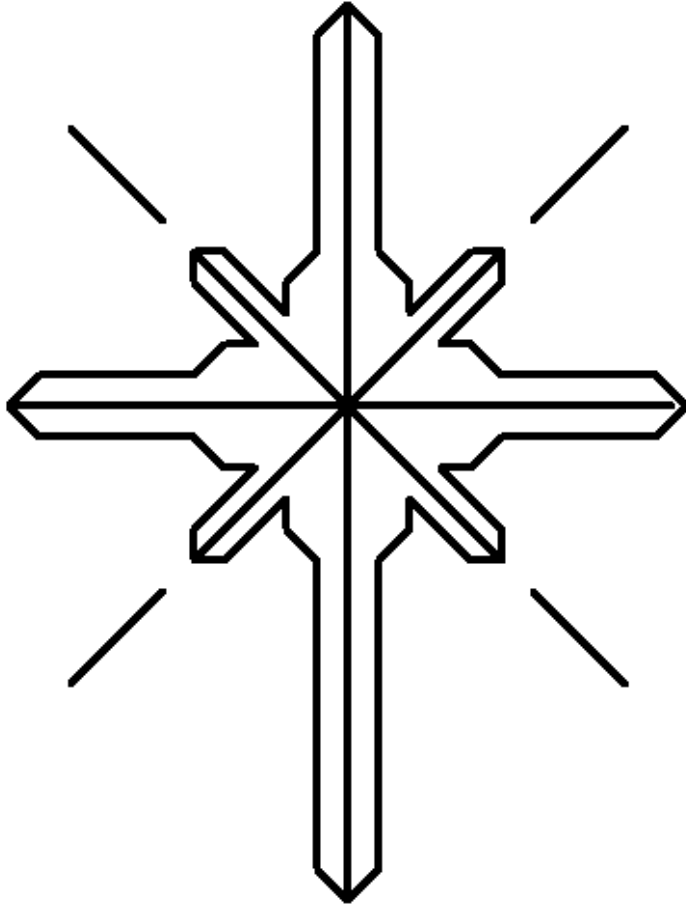


When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife. Matthew 1:24

God sent a star to guide the wise men to where Jesus was.

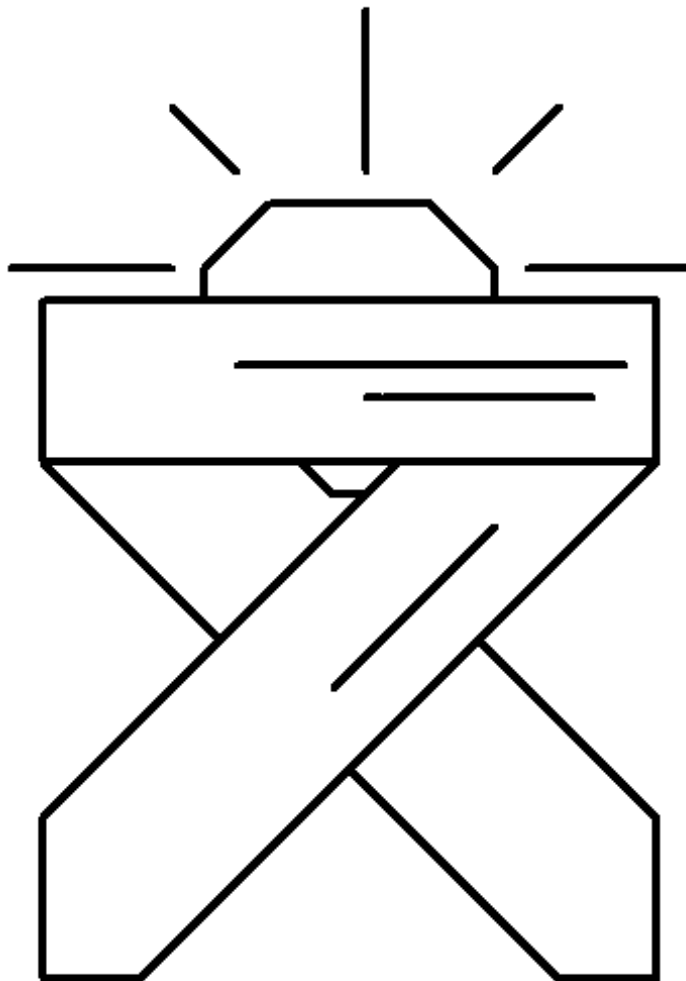


“Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews? We have seen his star in the east and have come to worship him.” Matthew 2:2

Mary wrapped him and put him in a manger.*

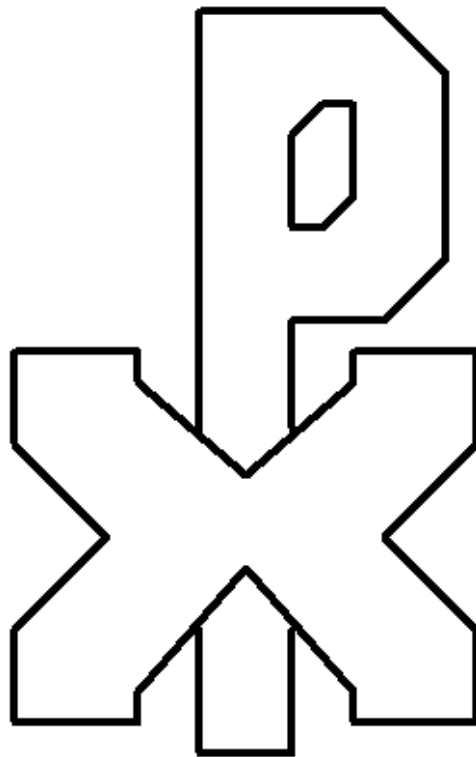
